Here is a list of things to do immediately after your credit card is lost/ stolen:

Note down the time and date when you realize that your card is missing. Also make sure that you inform your card issuer immediately after that.

If you are quick to report before the card is used by anyone, you would not be liable to pay for any unauthorized charges.

If your issuer allows, temporarily lock or disable your card to gain time for further searching your card.

Send an email to your issuer with your account number, date & time of card loss & when you reported it to keep a log of information.

Keep a tab on your credit card activity & contact the credit card company if you notice any fraudulent charges or suspicious activity.

Check if your insurance covers you for credit card theft & contact your insurance provider, if you are covered for the same.
