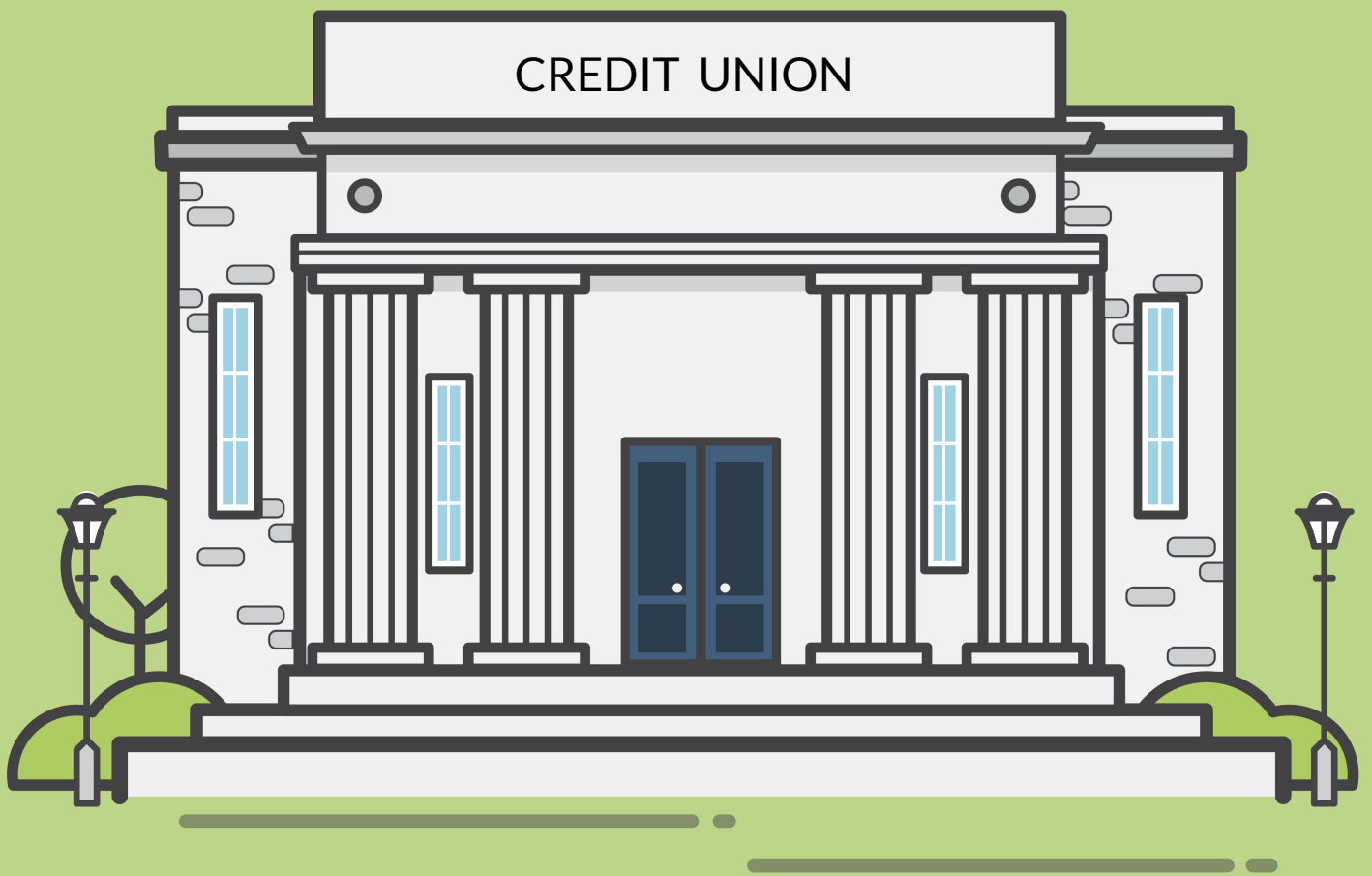


What Is A Credit Union?



A Credit Union is a not-for-profit cooperative. It is created, owned and operated by its members.



Credit Unions offer secure financial services and are insured by National Credit Union Administration (NCUA).



To become a member, applicants need to submit identification proof like a state-issued ID, social security card, etc.



Credit Unions offer a range of financial services like secured & unsecured loans, opening an account, direct deposits, online services, etc.



Every member of the Credit Union is an equal owner. The Board of Directors is also elected by the members.



Profits earned by a Credit Union are distributed among members in the form of dividends, low rate loans & other benefits.
